

## EXPLORE TED

### Steps

#### 1. History.

Originally, TED was looking to bring people together from the worlds of technology, entertainment and design. Since its beginning in 1984, it has become larger, covers more topics and starts more conversations than any other site on the Web. Find out about TED's history.

#### 2. Ideas worth spreading.

This mission brings free knowledge and inspiration to people globally. It includes business, sports and issues facing our world today among a myriad of other topics. TED looks for the world's most interesting speakers and does not limit itself to any geographical boundaries, religious dogma or cultural norms. Brainstorm things you'd like to know more about. What burning questions keep you awake at night? Remember, this is a global community of thinkers and movers so don't think small.

#### 3. Free.

To keep the ideas spreading, the best content collected at TED events is distributed free through their site, podcasts and more. Do a search for TED to see how widespread it is.

#### 4. Conferences.

TED distributes its ideas through conferences held worldwide. Attend a conference, if possible.

- TED Conference (Long Beach, California)
- TEDActive (Palm Springs, California)
- TEDGlobal (Edinburgh, Scotland)

#### 5. Smaller venues.

TED also has smaller conferences. Find out if one of these is being held near you.

- TED Salons (evening-length events)
- TEDx (TED-like experiences at local level)

#### 6. TEDTalks.

In an attempt to spread ideas as far as possible, TED makes the best presentations available on their Website. TEDTalks are also released as audio and video podcasts. Look at what is available on their site. There are links to online TED collections in "Sites to Explore" at the end of this badge program.

#### 7. Embracing the world.

The TED Open Translation Project takes TEDTalks and translates them for the world. There are more than 21,000 completed translations available in more than 70 languages. Explore the languages available.
