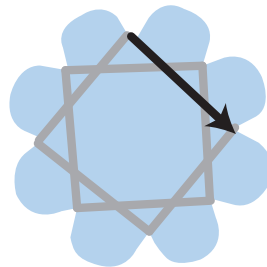
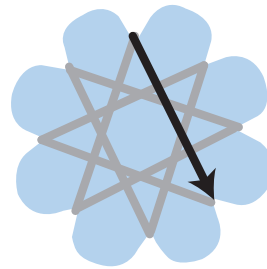

Spirella / spirelli

Spirella is a paper technique where you take a shape with a notched edge and wrap thread around it to make a pattern.

You can do one wrap layer, two layers with different colors, include photos or other items in the center as a focal point and more. You can use these shapes in scrapbooks, on cards, as Christmas ornaments and more.



Tools:

Punch OR template and pencil
Scissors

Materials:

Shape
Thread
Tape

Steps:

Make shape.

You can purchase a punch with notched edges. You can also find free templates online that you'll need to outline and cut out.

Select thread.

Choose to either compliment or contrast your thread color with your shape.

Tape the end.

Tape one end of your thread to the center of the back of your shape.

Wrap.

Wrap your thread through two notches on the front. If they are across from each other, you'll have a smaller hole in the center. When you've wrapped the entire circle tape down the end.
