Tools:

Paint brushes

Materials:

Round, flat rock

Acrylic paint

Acrylic sealer spray

Steps:

Rocks.

Find flat, round rocks in stream beds, on beaches or grab some at your craft store.

Paint.

Paint a design on the rock. This might be a picture, animal, pictograph or an abstract design.

Seal.

Spray sealer on the rock to help protect the paint.
