## Line Packman

All you need is an area with marked out lines. You can make your own with blue tape on a flat surface or chalk powder in a grassy area.

### **Area:**

Gym floor, basketball court, etc.  
(any play area with lines)

### **Materials:**

### **Rules:**

#### *Packman.*

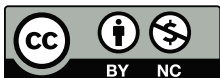
Choose one person to be packman.

#### *Play.*

All players walk along the lines. When the packman tags a player they sit down on the line and become a "block." Players have to turn around when they encounter a block. The packman can walk around the block to the other side.

The players acting as blocks allow the packman a way to corner players. If a player accidentally walks around a block, they are considered tagged and sit on the line next to the block they walked around.

When all but one player has been tagged, that player becomes packman and everyone starts moving along the lines again.
