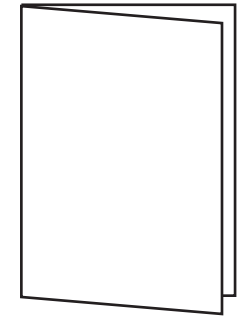


This minibook prints on one side of a single sheet of paper. After assembly, the final minibook will be 2.75" wide x 4.25" high. This size minibook is great to carry in a wallet or small purse. Kids like them because they're fun-size.

# Minibooks: Eighth-Sheets

For laying out this minibook, the top of all panels needs to be at the center of the page and the copy run to the edges. In our sample, the lower right corner will be the front cover after folding. Above the cover (and upside-down) will be page one. Across the top of the page, you'll continue with pages two to four and then continue around the page until you end with page seven next to the cover.

## Layout

The center solid line needs to be cut. It does not extend across the entire sheet, only the center panels. First fold in half lengthwise. The cut will be part of the first fold. Unfold so you have a flat sheet again. Then fold the sheet in half the other way (through the middle of the cut. Fold each side in half by aligning it with the center fold.

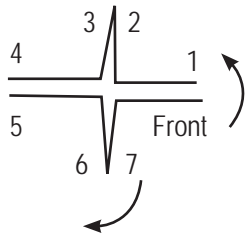
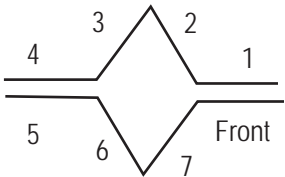
## Templates

You can find templates for a variety of eighth-sheet minibooks on Scribd, under the **larajla\_Template** collection.

You can stop at [larajla.com](http://larajla.com) for this template to create your own minibook. While you're there, sign up for my email list to be notified when additional templates, activity sheets and badge programs are released.

After creating these folds, refold in half lengthwise. Push the two ends together, opening up the center cut like a mouth. These two inside folds should be valleys so when you look down at the minibook from the top it looks like an "X". Then, fold the panels into the eight page minibook. See diagrams on the next page. Fold the "cover" and page 7 away from each other to complete the minibook.
