### Photo Scavenger Hunt NATURE HUNTS

Enjoy a walk through the woods or camp while scavenging for the perfect photos. Nature hunts allow you to explore the area without causing damage.

#### **Beauty in Nature**

Ask your hunters to show the beauty in nature with their photographs. Let everyone who participates vote for the most beautiful images. Prepare a display with the top shots, including the photographer's name, and find a place to put the display.

#### Camp

Feature your favorite camp with a photo scavenger hunt. You could do this as a history hunt, location based or "my favorite things" hunt. If you feel others might enjoy the hunt, make your materials re-usable and donate them to the camp for other groups.

#### Flora

Find and identify the most types of flora in a specific area. Provide books or sheets with shots of the different flora to minimize search time and increase hunting time.

#### **Flower Hunt**

Flowers can be sorted into hunts by color, shape, number of petals and more. You could also ask for the most unique flower shots.

#### **Insects Everywhere**

Your hunt could be for the most different types of insects. You could also ask for butterflies alone. Explore your intended area before starting on this hunt to make sure you have enough insects to give everyone a chance to find them.

#### Mommy and Baby

Find instances of at least one adult and one baby set of animals, birds, etc. This should be a quantity hunt with the most found.
