PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT NIGHT HUNTS

The world completely changes at night. Things seem further away. Noises seem louder. A photo scavenger hunt is a great way to take advantage of the night.

Glow Stick Hunt

Hide glow sticks within a certain area. Let your hunters find and photograph as many as they can find. Using multiple colors or groupings will help you tell which are unique photos and which are multiple shots of the same glow stick(s).

Illumination

Each team should have a flashlight. Use the flashlight to illuminate the items on your hunt for photos. This might include people's faces, shining spider eyes, etc.

Paint with Light

Use flashlights, glow sticks or sparklers to paint with light. As you take the photo, you'll see the light's path. You can ask for drawings of simple shapes to words.
