## PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT PLACED ITEM HUNTS

A great way to make sure your scavengers stay in a location and you have control over where they go is to place items for them to find. Normally, you'll need to purchase or make the items yourself for this type of hunt. While the items don't need to all be exactly the same, you want them similar enough to make sure people know they are part of the set they are looking for. Keep track of how many you place so you can make sure to collect them all when you're finished.

Placed item hunts can allow you to take a picture of each if you have a smaller amount — a couple dozen or less.

If you have a large number, you can ask participants to collect them after taking the picture to help you collect them and make it more challenging the longer the hunt lasts as there will be less to photograph.

You can even make a special one that calls attention to itself and have the person who takes the picture of the special one bring it in for a special prize. For example, if you hide 20 yard gnomes and they're all colored normally and one is gold, that one will definitely be sought after.

Making a story to go with the placed items. For example, place an outfit of clothing in various locations and explain why the pieces were scattered. The story can help add interest to the scavenger hunt.

So dive into this list of items with your imagination and see what you can come up with.

- Flower fairies
- Small cars
- Vintage cars (large hunt area)
- Certain type of flower
- Ribbons
- Entire outfit of clothing
- Yard gnomes
- Plastic flamingos
- Painted rocks
- Monster prints
- Feathers
- Faux birds
