# PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT PROP HUNTS

Liven up your hunt with props that need to be placed into the pictures. These items can be small and easy to include or completely wild and hard (or embarrassing) to move around. You can provide the props or ask your hunters to bring props from home. If you're asking for props to be provided by your hunters, you may want to include the props in the judging.

## **Decorative Chaos**

Ask each person to bring six to ten items to "decorate" items on the scavenger hunt list. Each team will then have numerous decorative props to choose from as they decorate before photographing. Make sure to award creativity in the shots.

#### **Mascot**

Let your team create a mascot or provide one. Let the mascot be placed in every shot. You might want the mascot to be interactive or it can just "sit there."

### Warm Up

Hats, scarves and mittens — everything you need for a cold winter's day. Put them on every item that needs to be "found" on the list and photographed. Don't limit it to people. Brainstorm items that can be decorated like fire hydrants and street signs. You might want to provide some blue painter's tape, especially if it's windy.
