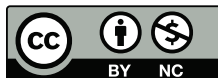

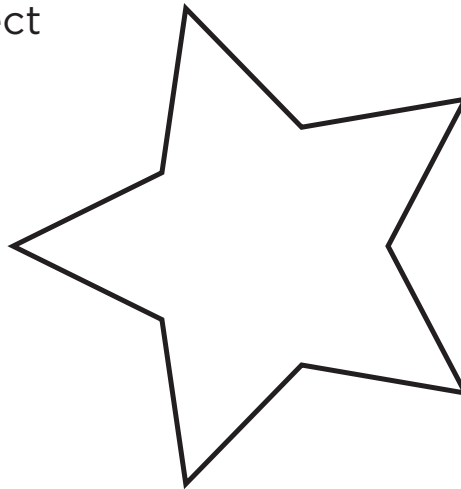

# Star SWAP

Decorate your star SWAP to reflect your fun personality!

The following page has a sheet you can print as a template to make as many stars as you need.

For your chipboard / cardboard, use recycled cereal boxes, shipping boxes, etc.



### **Tools:**

Scissors  
Pencil  
Hole punch  
Template

### **Materials:**

Chipboard or cardboard  
Safety pin  
Decorating materials, as desired  
Safety pin

### **Steps:**

#### *Template.*

Print the template on a heavy paper. Cut out the stars.

#### *Trace.*

Using the stars, trace around them onto a heavy chipboard or cardboard. Cut out your star.

#### *Punch.*

Punch a hole in one of the star points. This is where you will put your safety pin.

#### *Decorate as desired.*

Wrap with yarn or raffia. Color each side. Cover with stickers. These are just a few ideas. Make your own unique star SWAPs.

NOTE: Not enough time to cut stars? Pre-purchase wooden, cardboard, or other stars you can find.
