# Tape Sit Upon SWAP

For little fingers, this might be the easiest sit-upon SWAP yet.

### **Tools:**

Scissors  
Sharpie or other permanent marker

### **Materials:**

Duct tape, decorative  
Fun foam square  
Safety pin

---

### **Steps:**

#### *Fun foam.*

Find or cut out a fun foam square that is not as wide as the tape you're using.

#### *Add tape.*

Center foam on tape and press. Put a second piece of tape on top. Alternatively, you could fold the tape over the foam square. Be sure all edges are completely sealed. Trim tape edges about a quarter to half inch from the edge of the square.

#### *Faux stitch.*

Using the marker, make lines so it looks like stitching around the edges.

#### *Add pin.*

Put safety pin through edge where it is two thicknesses of tape.
