

☐ Baggie ☐ Bead	This SWAP creates a flag charm that can be used on a decorated safety pin so that it hangs freely.

\square Fabric / Fiber	TOOLS:
□ Holder	Scissors or paper cutter
☐ Holiday	1/8" hole paper punch
□ Nature	Jewelry pliers Laminator (or clear contact paper)
□ Non-Pin	
☐ Paint	MATERIALS: Flag, attached
■ Paper	O-ring
■ Pin	Glue
	Safety pin
Recycled	STEPS:
☐ Theme	Assemble. Print the insert. Cut it down as indicated. Fold in half.

☐ Various / Other	Laminate. Laminate so it extends on all edges with extra on the top edge.
Ll	Laminate 30 it externas on all eages with extra on the top eage.
	Attach. Punch a hole in the upper left corner. Punch should be through laminate only to minimize chance of moisture destroying the paper. Attach an O-ring.
	Pin. Decorate your pin as desired or leave it empty. Attach the flag to the pin with the O-rings.
	NOTE: Depending on your ability there are two ways to do this. Put the first O-ring on the flag. Put the ring on the pin, add beads, then put the second O-ring. You can also put on the beads, then add the O-rings for both corners at the same time. Use what works best for you.
	ALTERNATIVE: You can create a paper bead slightly smaller than the area between the O-rings and roll it onto the pin, then add the flag.
