Flag Pole: Maryland

This SWAP creates a flag on a pole. I would recommend putting it into a baggie to keep it dry since it would be difficult to laminate and protect the paper. You may instead choose to print on cardstock and put the pin through the “flag” itself.

TOOLS:

Cutters, wire or similar
Scissors or paper cutter

MATERIALS:

Jewelry zip top bag, 2” x 3”
Toothpick (flag pole)
Bag insert, attached
Glue
Safety pin

STEPS:

Assemble.

Print the insert. Cut it down as indicated. Fold in half.

Insert.

Place the toothpick in the flag fold and glue the paper so that it helps hold the “pole” in place. See image above.

NOTE: You can change the length of the toothpick by cutting some of it off.

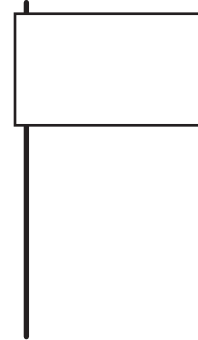
Place.

Place flag into the baggie. Seal shut.

NOTE: You can add other items in your bag beyond the flag or use the flag as an inclusion in a different baggie SWAP.

Pin.

Add safety pin outside the zip-top
