Bubble Wands

Even as an adult, I love to play with bubbles. Why not make your own wands? From drinking straws to pipe cleaners, you can make a wide variety of wands.

Don't feel restrained by using a circle. Try squares, triangles and other fun shapes!

TOOLS:

- Scissors
- Wire cutters

MATERIALS:

- Drinking straws
- Pipe cleaners
- Wire hanger
- Wire
- String
- Beads
- Dowels

STEPS:

1. Hand as a bubble wand — Make a circle with your hand, dip and blow.
2. Drinking straws as a bubble wand — Just dip and blow. You can also grab a bunch and tie them together snugly to get a lot of small bubbles. Just make sure you can fit the bunch in your mouth.
3. Pipe cleaners as a bubble wand — Twist two pipe cleaners together. At one end, open up a "circle" to use in the solution. Alternatively, you can wrap a pipe cleaner around a shape (like a cookie cutter) on one end.
4. Wire as a bubble wand — Find decorative, colored wire at your local craft store. Cut and shape to any style of closed shape.
