Invisible Ink: Baking Soda

TOOLS:

Light bulb (heat source)

Paintbrush or similar

Measuring cup

MATERIALS:

Baking soda

Paper

Water

Purple grape juice, optional

STEPS:

There are at least two methods to use baking soda as an invisible ink. Mix equal parts of water and baking soda.

Use a cotton swab, toothpick or paintbrush to write a message on white paper. Allow "ink" to dry. Read message by holding paper up to a heat source. The baking soda will turn brown.

If no heat method, paint over paper with purple grape juice.
